

Local Community Service Project

Mrs. Georgiana Pinkney is the Founder, President, and Chief Executive Officer of <u>Greater Life of Fayetteville</u>, Inc. established in 2012. The nonprofit organization offers children grades 1-8, who have been placed on short-term out-of-school suspension, after-school tutoring for those in jeopardy of arrest; and a 5-week "I Am YOU-nique Summer Academy" based on the student's grades and demonstrated conduct.

The organization hosts Parent Community Workshops and other programs throughout the year in Cumberland County and surrounding areas. She is a creative orchestrator in collaboration with the Board of Directors with other programs within Greater Life, such as An Etiquette Affair, We Celebrate You, Through My Eyes, ARTS and Academics, and partners with other organizations. She a mentor for the Urban Ministry, the Find-a-Friend Program; graduated from both the Cumberland County and the City of Fayetteville Citizen's Academy and the United Way Leadership Program. Her participation led to opportunities to serve on the Fayetteville-Cumberland Human Relations Commission, Greater Fayetteville United, NAACP, NAACP Education Coalition, and Fayetteville-Cumberland Ministerial Council Education Committee chair.

Mrs. Pinckney was also one of Fayetteville Senior Federation Club's "Women of Distinction" in 2023. **Thank you for your cooperation.**

- 2. Please provide an Official Copy of your High School Transcripts.
- 3. Please provide an Official Copy of your Proof of Enrollment from the 4-year College or University or 2-year college that you plan to attend.
